

DOMAINE ROGER & DIDIER RAIMBAULT

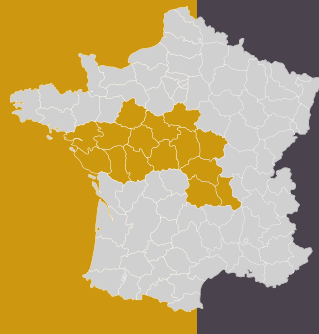

Once just 2 hectares in the 1960s, Domaine Raimbault now spans 51 plots in the rugged hills of the communes of Verdigny and Sury-en-Vaux. These hills, ranging from 200 to 400 meters in altitude and reaching slopes of up to 40%, offer diverse exposures and terroirs that contribute complexity and authenticity to the estate's wines.

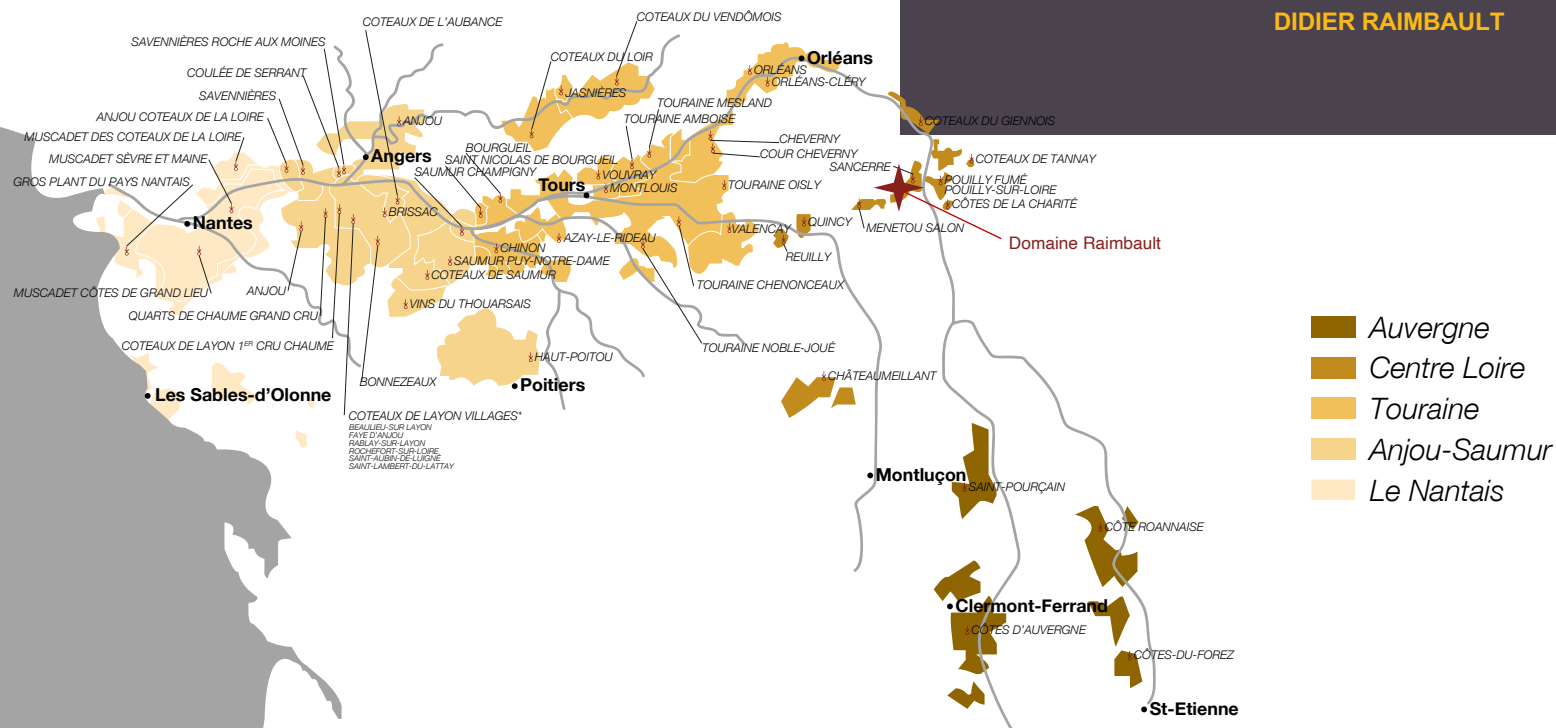
WHAT WE LIKE

- ∞ **Minerality.** A true reflection of the two main terroirs of the estate – white soils and gravel – minerality adds freshness and finesse to the typical citrus aromas of Sancerre and its grape variety, Sauvignon Blanc.
