

DOMAINE LAFRAN-VEYROLLES

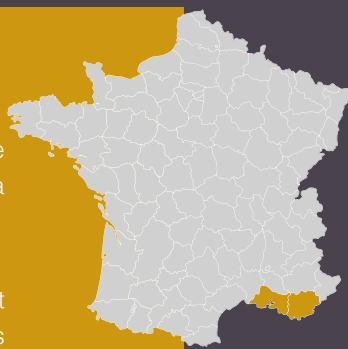

In the 15th century, the land of the Lafran-Veyrolles Domaine was planted with oak trees, which gave it its name ROVAYROLA. Since then, the name has changed to VEYROLLES, but the land is still there, planted today with vines. One of the first Bandols, it was in the 1940s that the estate was enlarged and reconstituted to become what it is today.

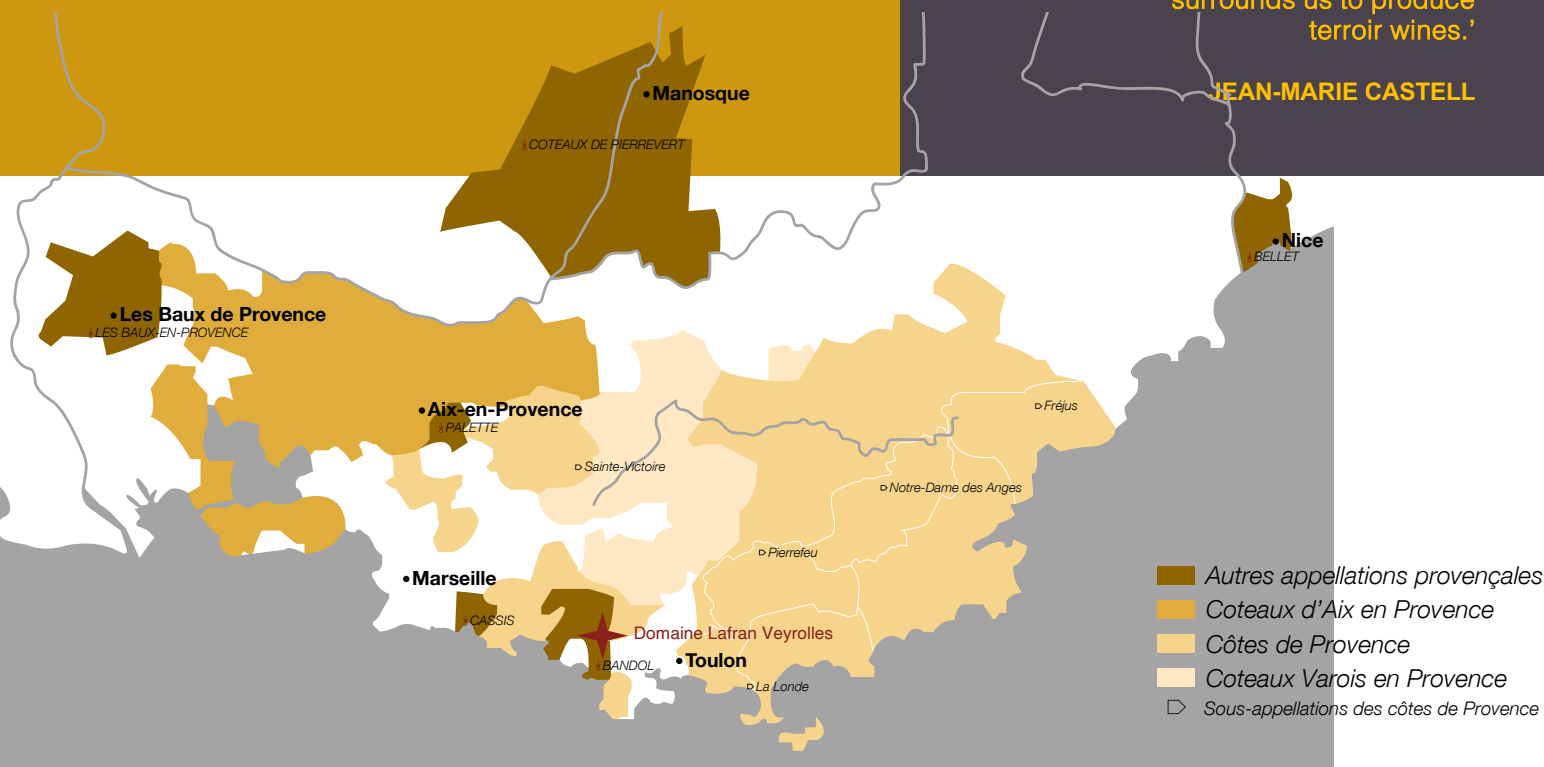
WHAT WE LIKE
