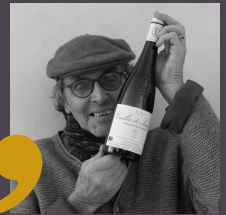


Owned exclusively by the Joly family, the Coulée de Serrant vineyard is a single appellation contrôlée covering just 7 hectares. The vineyard was planted in 1130 by Cistercian monks and today includes vines aged between 35 and 80 years. Biodynamic since 1984, two other wines are produced here: Les Vieux Clos and Le Clos de la Bergerie.

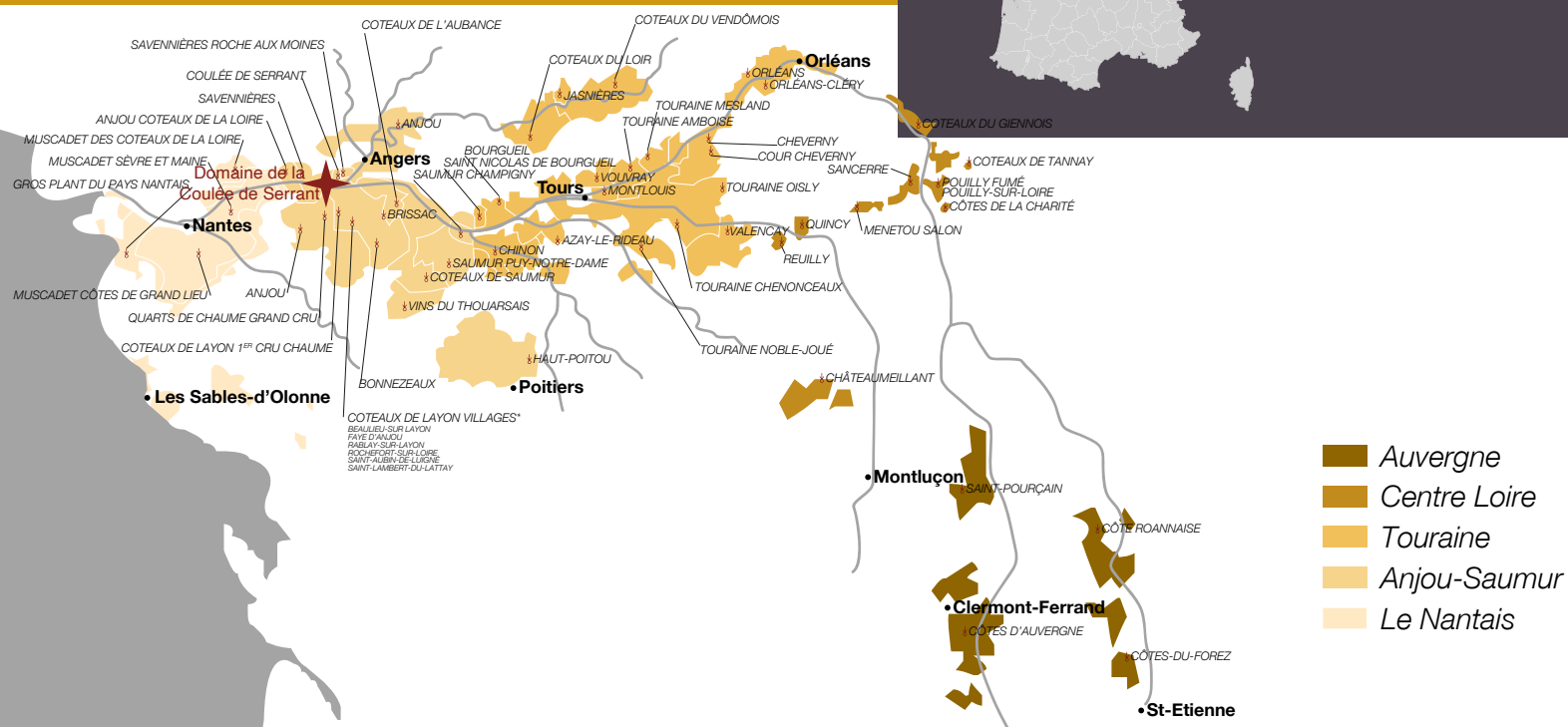
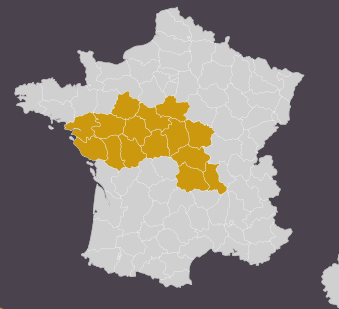
