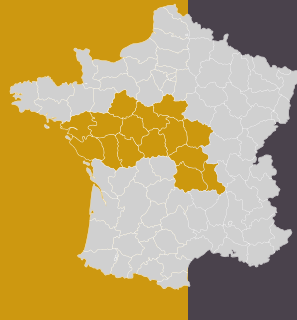

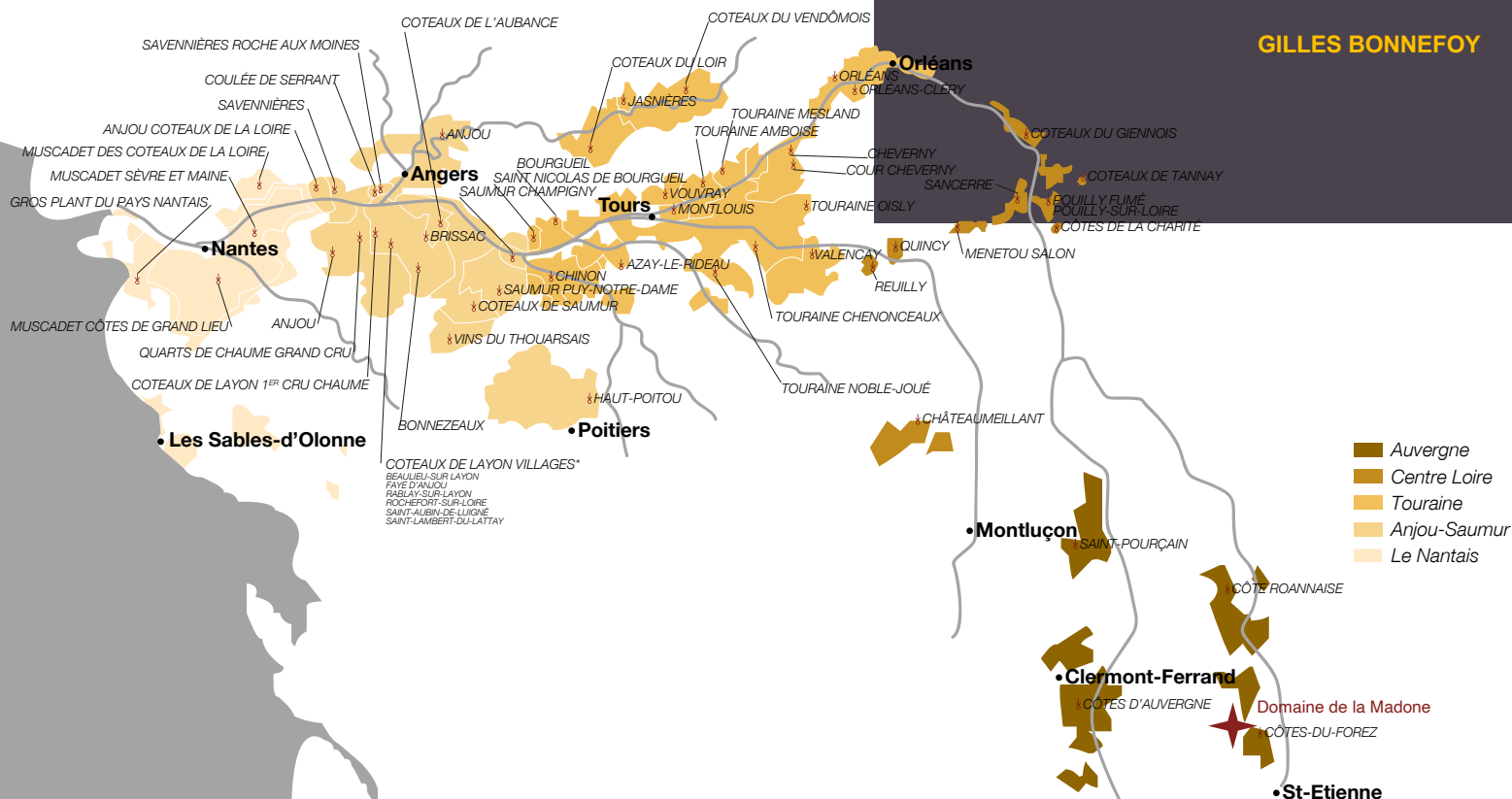
WHAT WE LIKE

The terroir. - The Côtes du Forez are separated by a geological fault, so there are two very distinct types of soil that give this vineyard its richness. Gilles Bonnefoy has succeeded in bringing out the typicity of these soils by vinifying each parcel on its own to accentuate its identity.
