
CHÂTEAU ROUQUETTE SUR MER

- Salinity. Present in both the whites and the reds, salinity is clearly expressed in the different cuvées of the estate, adding a beautiful freshness
- The diversity of the Clape terroir. The maritime influence, combined with an alternation of limestone and marl, allows for the coexistence of grape varieties with different biological requirements.
